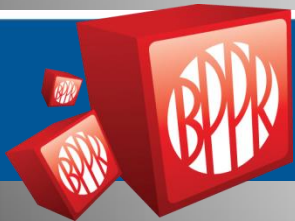

The most basic of all human needs is the need to understand and be understood. The best way to understand people is to listen to them. — Ralph Nichols

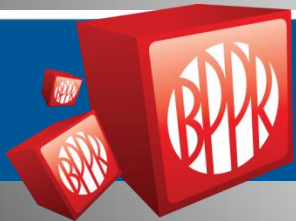

Never tell people how to do things. Tell them what to do, and they will surprise you with their ingenuity. – General George S. Patton

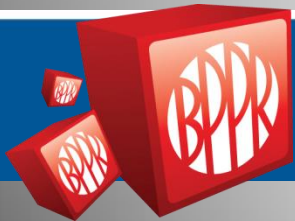

Great leaders are almost always great simplifiers, who can cut through argument, debate and doubt to offer a solution everybody can understand. – General Colin Powell

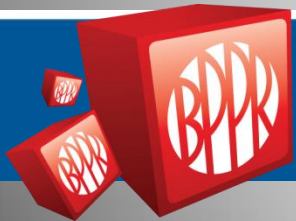
